Key Updates:

- Current Activities
 - o Finalize building plans for permit application and more detailed costing
 - o Reviewing key areas for possible improvements and increased value
 - Examples are Heating & Cooling, Electrical, Plumbing, Canopy, Sound Curtain, Kitchen Equip, Etc.
 - o Preparing detailed construction schedule for subcontractor review
 - o Construction administration planning (how changes are handled, budget is managed, bills are paid, daily activity log, etc)
 - o Financial planning (construction loan, insurance, schedule of values for cost management, etc.)
- Preliminary Schedule / Milestone Dates
 - o Late July: Completion of updated building plans and schedule for permit application and subcontractor review
 - o August: Subcontractor plan and schedule review; update costs and budget
 - o First Saturdays in August 2015 – Volunteer opportunity for west side demolition work (more information to come)
 - o September 2015: Excavating, Foundations, Concrete for addition
 - o October thru December 2015: Framing and close in addition
 - o **January 4, 2016 – Existing Fellowship Hall taken out of service; until as late as August 1, 2016**
